Motorist Fails to Stop For Officers

On 07/18/2020 Officers Salovitz and Wadsworth were conducting stationary radar on Lincoln St. At approximately 10:00 pm a white Ford Ranger was observed traveling west on Lincoln St. at a speed greater than the posted speed limit. After the vehicle passed the officers, it accelerated to 60MPH.

The officers immediately activated their emergency lighting and siren, while attempting to stop the vehicle. The vehicle continued to accelerate away from the officers and traveled onto Mayflower St. towards the police station. The vehicle was observed operating erratically and dangerously. The officers notified the shift supervisor that the vehicle was headed towards the police station and that they were slowing their pursuit of it. Sgt. Jamali was at the police station and informed officers he was going to deploy a vehicle tire deflation device in order to stop the vehicle's dangerous actions.

Sgt. Jamali observed the vehicle as it approached the police station continuing to travel at a very high rate of speed. He deployed the Stinger Spike Strips directly in front of the police station. The Ford Ranger drove over the spike strips causing the tires to safely deflate. The Ford stopped just west of the police station where Officer Hunter and Sgt. Jamali were able to place 27-year-old Brian Price from Marshfield into custody without incident.

Mr. Price was arrested and charged with Failing to Stop for Police, Negligent Operation of a Motor Vehicle, Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Suspended License for OUI, Failing to Stay in Marked Lanes, and Speeding.
