# Man Facing Armed Robbery Charges Arrested by Duxbury Officers 

June 2, 2017 - Last night, Duxbury Police arrested a man wanted by the Weymouth Police Department for multiple violent felonies. At approximately 4PM Weymouth Police requested assistance in locating Michael J. Sheehan, age 31. Sheehan was believed to be living with relatives at a King Philip's Path home in Duxbury. Weymouth Police held an outstanding arrest warrant for Sheehan for failing to appear in court on charges of Armed Robbery, Aggravated Assault and Battery with a Dangerous Weapon, Kidnapping, Witness Intimidation, and several other charges.

At approximately 6PM Duxbury Officers spotted Sheehan near the residence and attempted to make contact with him. Sheehan retreated into the residence and refused to answer the door. Officers from Duxbury, Marshfield, and Pembroke secured the area and a search warrant for the home was obtained.

At approximately 8:30PM Duxbury and Pembroke officers entered the home and located Sheehan in a basement area. He was taken into custody without resistance. After being booked at the Duxbury Police Station, Sheehan was transferred to the Plymouth County House of Correction.
